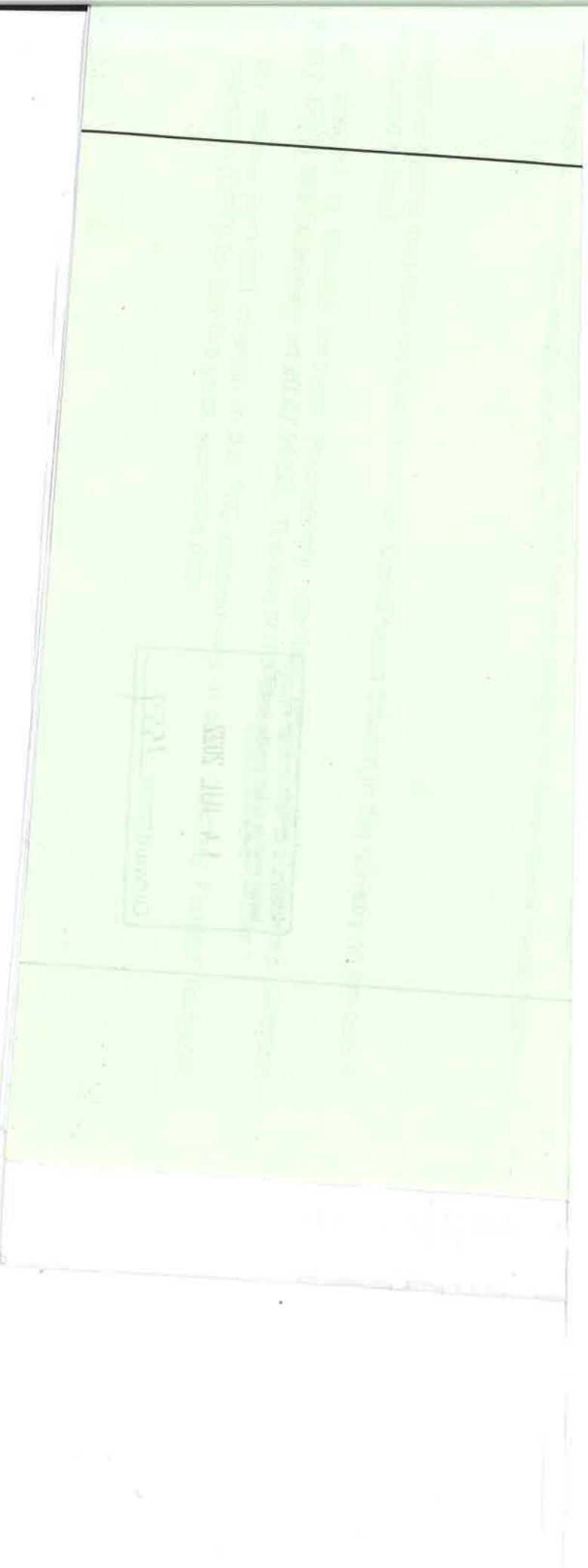

CIRCULAR

Subject: Teaching Assistantship (TA) guidelines for UG students

The following guidelines on revised roles and responsibilities is proposed for the TAs is as under:

1. Teaching assistantship shall include assisting faculty members in conduct of courses e.g. grading of homework, tutorials independently following the instructions given.
2. Additionally teaching assistantship may also include assisting faculty members in grading examination papers, quizzes, assignment and term papers in presence of faculty members and ONLY under their supervision.
3. Teaching assistants should participate in tutorials and laboratory classes in presence of faculty members. The TAs are also supposed to help in recording/uploading attendance data for courses.
4. In case of courses conducted through synchronized learning mode, teaching assistants may assist in sorting and analysing the queries raised by the candidates during the online session and also meet any additional requirement from time to time. They may also resolve/monitor those queries working closely with the instructors.
5. The senior UG students can be TAs in teaching the first year students.
6. The students to be acting as TA, must have to complete the respective courses with at least 'A-' grade.

Terms of reference: UG students can also serve as TA for 1st and 2nd year UG courses. A 3rd year UG student can participate for TA duty of 1st year courses whereas 4th year students can participate for TA duty of 1st and 2nd year courses. UG students can be allocated a maximum *four* hours of TA duty per week. A student with CGPA 8.0 and above will be eligible for the same. The student would be given assistantship of Rs. 6000 per month for 4hr/week Teaching Assistantship (proportionately) for the same.

The assistantship for UG students will be processed on recommendation of the course instructor and head of the department from the recurring budget of the department. For institute level courses being managed by the Office of Academics/Students, the assistantship will be released based on recommendation of the course instructor and respective Associate Dean. Allocation of UG students in department level courses will be managed by respective departments.
