Kindly refer to your email dated December 01, 2023 regarding the subject cited above; the pointwise Response of the ibid email in regard to IIT Kanpur is as under:

(a) whether the IIT's of the country /Government received complaints of discriminatory recruitment practices to sideline Reserved Category students like SC/ST and other Backward Classes;

Response: IIT Kanpur did not receive any complaint from any of its students participating in the placement process this year about any discriminatory practices targeting Reserved Category students, including SC/ST and other Backward Classes, during the recruitment process. However, the institute has received email, from a few alumni, expressing such concerns that a few companies use JEE ranks to discriminate against reserved category students.

(b) if so, the details thereof;

Response: As stated above, IIT Kanpur did not receive any such complaint from any of its students sitting for the placement. However, a few alumni have sent emails alerting that a few private companies have asked the students participating in the placement to provide their ranks in the JEE exams. They further alleged that the companies used this information for the identifying students in the reserved categories and possibly discriminated against them; it should be reiterated here that the institute does not allow the companies to collect information on the category (SC/ST/OBS etc) of the students sitting for the placement not does it share any such personal details to any third party.

(c) the steps taken by the Government to check such alarming situation in Government owned Higher Institutes of the country; and

Response: As stated above, IIT Kanpur, as a policy, does not share category of the students (SC/ST/OBC etc) to any outsider including private recruiters, and nor does it allow recruiters to collect this information while they are on campus for the placement drive. Given the allegation that the recruiters possibly use the JEE rank to identify students under the reserved category, the Institute has barred the companies to collect the JEE rank details from the students sitting for campus placement.

(d) the details of such private companies who forced the students to reveal their caste and entrance rank list details?

Response: As stated above, neither IIT Kanpur share with the recruiters the personal details of the students (caste or reservation category) sitting for the campus placement not does it allow the recruiters participating in the campus recruitment drive to collect such information. There was an allegation that a company named 'Merilytics' requesting for JEE ranks of the students and they might use it to identify the reserved category students. The Institute intervened and this information was later removed from the application form after discussion with the company.

Vacant posts for non-teaching positions are also re-advertised through special drives to boost up the recruitment.

Kindy refer to your e-mail dated January 30, 2024 on the above subject matter. In this context, the point wise reply to the question nos. (a) to (e) in so far they relate to this Institute are as under:

(a) Whether any initiative or programs have the government undertaken to promote skill development across different sectors and industries in India

Reply: Yes, IIT Kanpur is part of various activities listed below:

- i. PMKVY Pradhan Mantri Kaushal Vikas Yojana under PMKVY, we have proposed the following courses: Automotive Additive Manufacturing Technicians, Automation and Robotics Engineer, Mechatronics Designer and System Integrator, Kisan drone Operator.
- ii. Formation and operation of Indian Institute of Skills (IIS) Kanpur jointly with National Skill Training Institute (NSTI), Kanpur: In this activity, there will be a vertical of 18 laboratories, the details of which are attached herewith. HAL and Dassault Aviation are partners in this work. The infrastructure for the IIS is already ready, and the laboratories are currently being developed. IIT Kanpur also provides skill upgrade training to HAL trainees once a year under a joint MoU. The scope and deliverables of IIS are available in the document.

The Ministry of Micro, Small, and Medium Enterprises (MSME) has collaborated with prominent technical institutions to provide opportunities for aspiring entrepreneurs and industrial sector employees to enhance their skills. The collaborative efforts aim to address the market's evolving needs through skill development initiatives. In the fiscal year 2022-23, the Ministry of MSME conducted 60 programs. The curriculum for these programs is proposed by different institutes, ensuring relevance and effectiveness in skill development. The topics are chosen to reflect the contemporary needs of different sectors and industries, promoting a holistic approach to skill enhancement.

Subject: Rajya Sabha admitted Question No. 407 for 06.02.2024 regarding "Machine for testing blood sugar"

Shri Ashwini,

Kindy refer to your e-mail dated February 01, 2024 on the above subject matter. In this context, the point wise reply to the question nos. (a) to (e) are as under:

(a) Whether Government is aware that a scientist of IIT Kanpur has invented a machine for testing blood sugar through human sweat;

Reply: A complete machine ready for deployment has not been made yet. There is ongoing research work on the process of making some of the components of the envisaged machine.

(b) if so, the details thereof;

Reply: The complete machine has not been made yet, hence details of it are not ready.

(c) Whether Government also granted patent to this machine;

Reply: The complete machine has not been made and hence a patent for the complete machine has not been applied.

(d) Whether it is a fact that the machine – Non-enzymatic Electro Chemical Sweat Glucose Analytical Device – is the fastest device to get blood sugar results in just 1-2 minutes; and

Reply: The envisaged device is expected to give the results in about 1-2 minutes. The exact time will be known after the complete device is subjected to tests.

(e) the efforts being made to propagate and use this device in all hospitals of the country?

Reply: This envisaged machine is being worked upon and is not ready for deployment yet.

(b) The steps taken by the government to collaborate with educational institutions and industries to align skill development with the evolving needs of the job market

Reply: The government has undertaken strategic collaborations to align skill development programs with the dynamic requirements of the job market. This collaborative effort spans the financial years 2022-23 and 2023-24.

Specifically, IIT Kanpur, in partnership with the Ministry of Micro, Small and Medium Enterprises (MSME), has been actively involved in implementing skill development programs since the fiscal year 2022-23. This collaboration involves the design and execution of programs such as Advanced Entrepreneurship and Skill Development Programmes (A-ESDP) and Advanced Management Development Programmes (A-MDP). These programs encompass a range of topics, including Entrepreneurship Skill Development on the Internet of Things, Data Science and Data Analytics, Social and Sustainable Entrepreneurship, and various others. The curriculum is carefully crafted to address the specific skill requirements identified in consultation with industry stakeholders. The government aims to foster a symbiotic relationship between academia and industry by engaging with premier educational institutions like IIT Kanpur. This approach ensures that skill development initiatives not only meet the current needs of the job market but also remain adaptable to future advancements and changes in industry dynamics. The collaborative efforts are geared towards producing a workforce that is well-equipped with the latest skills and competencies. contributing significantly to the overall growth and competitiveness of the nation.

During the last two years, the "Skill Development Initiative (SDI) in Woman's Tailor" was conducted for the unemployed youths of 15 Gram Panchayat in Kalyanpur Block, Kanpur District. The program has been recently completed, and 305 female participants have been provided with the completion certificate.

(c) The details on the geographical reach of skill development programs and whether there are targeted efforts for rural and underserved areas.

Reply: IIT Kanpur is in the process of developing certificate courses on skill development and entrepreneurship for the rural sector through IIS in the following areas:

- (i) Agricultural Technology
- (ii) Medical Healthcare Technology
- (iii) Additive Manufacturing
- (iv) Smart Textile and Design Engineering

Other programs that our institute runs are listed below:

The Ranjit Singh Rozhi Shiksha Kendra (RSK) and Unnat Bharat Abhiyan (UBH) have collaborated to educate rural children and skills to rural youth for better employability. Several programs have been implemented under this initiative:

- 1. Sewing Machine Operator Course (NSQF Level 4):
 - I trained 350 rural youth (Dec 2020-March 2023), and 60% are employed in the local apparel industry.
 - Partnership with Pratham Education Initiative and support of NABARD.
- 2. Artisan Training Vishwakarma Shram Samman Yojana:
 - Facilitation of training for potters in the Bithorn area at the District Industries Centre, Kanpur Nagar.
 - 60 potters registered, 42 trained, and organized skill courses for product upgradation.
- 3. Digital Literacy (PMG-DISHA):
 - Trained 100 rural youth in 12 villages on PMGDISHA with the help of IIT Kanpur students.
- 4. G2C Services through Rural Camps:
 - Conducted camps in several villages for government scheme registrations
- 5. Computer Basics for Rural Youth:
 - Computer training for rural youth by IITK students
- 6. Training Youth for Enumeration of the 7th Economic Census:
 - 35 rural youth were trained as enumerators for the 7th Economic.
- 7. Promoting Organic Farming:
 - Organized an exposure visit for farmers.
 - Conducted demonstrations and talks on organic farming and drip irrigation.
 - Promoting online sales through the Aranyaani online portal.

8. Rural Vaccination Drive:

- Organized a vaccination camp in Singhpur and a drive in a dozen villages during May-June 2021 to promote Covid vaccination.
- Education of Rural School-Going Children:
- Set up tuition centers in 3 villages (2018-2019), handling 80 school-going children.
- An online education model for after-school tuition for rural school children

These initiatives reflect a comprehensive approach to addressing rural communities' educational and skill development needs, covering diverse sectors such as sewing, artisan training, digital literacy, organic farming, and vaccination awareness, among others. The collaboration involves partnerships with various organizations and leverages the expertise of IIT Kanpur students and faculty.

Hackathon on Minor Forest Produce

FIRST IIT Kanpur organized a "Hackathon for Minor Forest Produce" with Chhattisgarh State Minor Forest Produce (Trading and Development) Co-operative Federation Limited. This event is for developing technological solutions for the value addition of Minor Forest Produce (Tamarind, Mahua Seed, Lac, Bhelwa, Sal Seed, Harra, Baheda, Jamun, Jack Fruit, Tendu Fruit). The objective is to provide higher value for the Minor Forest Produce (MFP) to create social impact and create job opportunities and livelihood for tribal beneficiaries in the state of Chhattisgarh. This program is a medium for technology transfer to tribal for processing and value addition of MFPs. This includes scouting for the best technological solutions for the MFPs. Once the tribal gets the know-how of value addition of the MFPs and starts producing the value-added products, their income will increase significantly.

Tech for Tribal

Tech for Tribal is a unique program to make the tribal of India "Aatmanirbhar." TRIFED, Ministry of Tribal Affairs, and Gol have funded this nationwide program to bridge the gap between tribal entrepreneurs and urban markets. The project aims to develop Tribal holistically, focusing on entrepreneurship development, soft skills, IT, and business development through Self Help Groups that operate through Van Dhan Vikas Kendras (VDVK).

Tech for Tribal was officially launched on October 13, 2020. The primary objective of this training is to introduce the tribal trainees to relevant concepts for operating a business in a rural setup and provide them insights about making their products market-ready.

The project, Tech for Tribal, implemented by FIRST IIT Kanpur, touches the lowest stratum of society, focusing on capacity building of rural women by empowering them to become financially independent. We are working across **Kerala**, **Chhattisgarh**, **Tamil Nadu**, and **Andhra Pradesh**.

Major Outcomes:

Ensured sustainable livelihood for around 3175 women members working in SHGs with Van Dhan Vikas Kendras at different levels.

- ✓ Directly Indirectly impacted around 12000 members from the Tribal community in a span of two years across the four states.
- ✓ Promoting and setting up rural enterprises with the help of locally available resources through skill training, linkages for financial and business support, and handholding.
- ✓ Strengthening ownership, institutions, and collective accountability.
- ✓ Value addition of various minor forest produce collected by the forest-dwelling tribal gatherers was done to help them generate higher income that eventually improves their quality of life with better access to education and health opportunities.
- (d) Whether there is any success stories or case studies that showcase the impact of India's skilled workforce in international markets
