



NSS IITD has conducted several activities in the period May 2020 – Dec 2020, highlights of which are provided below.

1. Online activities post the lockdown:

- i. Online sensitization webinars and interactive activities, such as Mind Over Matter series in collaboration with NSS GGSIPU and RERF, Webinar with Mr. Rajendra Singh, etc.
- ii. A new website for Blog was introduced. The blog articles, along with Fact of Friday series and our Instagram posts highlighting social issues have been received well.
- iii. We mentored 11 students for over a period of 2-3 months for their self-arranged internship.
- iv. Regular online tutoring sessions for 3 children from slums under F4T project.
- v. Prepared an All India Database of NGOs covering almost all the districts of India.
- vi. Set up an active volunteer group helping in preparing quality content (like care packages, collecting motivational stories) for mental health issues.
- vii. Online activities to increase people's interaction with the environment, such as gardening activities.
- viii. Designing fun activities for students to spend more time with their grandparents.
- ix. Gender sensitization and substance abuse survey, along with informative videos.
- x. Prepared 200+ bilingual assignments and study material to be used in our volunteering activities later on.
- xi. She Codes Project: Aims to motivate the girls to take up engineering and computer sciences as their future career. Our initial target audience included 860+ girls over 23 schools with execution structure in 3 levels comprising executive team, teachers and facilitators and lastly students. We introduced animation classes post lockdown. Flip-A-Clip tutorials were uploaded on NSS IIT Delhi official YouTube channel, which eases the access of tutorial video and also increases the reach of the channel, with almost all tutorial videos getting 0.5-1K views and counting. Some Girls get Even motivated to start their own Youtube Channel.
- xii. In a collaboration with AAIP, NSO and EDURIDE, NSS volunteers helped facilitate transport for 200+ JEE MAINS students who were located in remote locations and were unable to obtain a means of transport to their exam centre.
- xiii. Regular Volunteering teaching students of class 3rd – 10th in VIDYA project, in collaboration with Super School Initiative India
- xiv. Were able to sanction 40kg of dry dog food through HSI India in response to the need for the stray animals residing in campus
